Re: Year 11 Mock Examinations - Monday 18 to Friday 29 November 2019

I am pleased to be able to share with you the details of the mock exams that your child will complete during the November mock exam period. These mock exams are an important part of the work that your child is completing to prepare for their GCSE examinations next summer, which are now only a matter of months away.

Your child has been given a personalised statement of exam entry for the mock exams, which lists each of the exams that your child will complete.

Revision breakfasts

Before every morning exam there will be a revision breakfast session starting at 7.30am. The revision breakfast is a fantastic opportunity for students to complete final preparations for each exam, including receiving a free hot bacon or egg sandwich. This is an important part of preparing for each exam - just as we will do in the summer GCSE exams - and we hope that every student takes up this opportunity.

Morning exams

Students with a morning exam should arrive at school at 7.30am and join their teachers in their normal classrooms. After breakfast is served, students will leave bags and coats in the room next to the main hall before meeting in the Main Hall at 8.30am. Examinations will commence promptly at 8.45am.

Afternoon exams

Students with an afternoon exam will go to lunch at 12.00pm before leaving bags and coats in the room next to the main hall before meeting in the library at 12.30pm. Examinations will commence promptly at 12.45pm.

Students without an exam will go to normal timetabled lessons and attend lunch at the normal time.
