Dear Year 8 Parent/Carer

Free School Meal (FSM) Provision for Year 8 Students during self-isolation

Thank you for your continued patience and understanding following last week's Public Health guidance for our Year 8 to stay at home and self-isolate, with a return to school on Monday 21 September.

I am pleased to inform you that we have been working closely with our catering provider, Robertson FM to ensure that students who are eligible to receive free school meals are able to access lunch provision during their self-isolation period.

I can confirm that a food hamper, that contains the equivalent of two weeks' worth of school meals, is available for collection at the school on Monday 14 September between 11am – 12noon, for those families with a Year 8 child eligible for free school meals.

Please can you arrange for you, or a family member/friend who is not self-isolating, to come and collect the hamper at some point in the one hour time slot on Monday. For obvious reasons this person should not be your Year 8 child.

Alongside this letter that we are texting to the parents of Year 8 who qualify for FSM, we are also providing links to two other documents. Please do not come onto the school site if you are experiencing any Covid-19 symptoms. If possible, arrange a friend or family member to collect the hamper instead.
